



Isolated strong to severe thunderstorms are also possible

OVERVIEW:

- Hazardous heat continues through at least Friday with a gradual cooling trend over the weekend.
- Isolated strong to severe storms are possible this afternoon into tonight and again Friday afternoon. Gusty winds and hail will be the greatest threats.

TIMING

- Heat peaks today, followed by another very hot day Friday. Some heat impacts may linger into Saturday.
- Isolated strong to severe storms this afternoon into tonight and again Friday.

HAZARDS & IMPACTS

- Heat related illnesses increase significantly during extreme heat and high humidity events. An [Extreme Heat Warning and Heat Advisories](#) are in effect for NH and portions of ME. Heat Indices (feels like temps) around 105-110° are likely.
- Overnight low temps in the 70s, resulting in accumulated heat stress.
- Storms may be capable of producing hail and locally damaging winds, which could pose a power outage threat and increase potential heat related impacts.

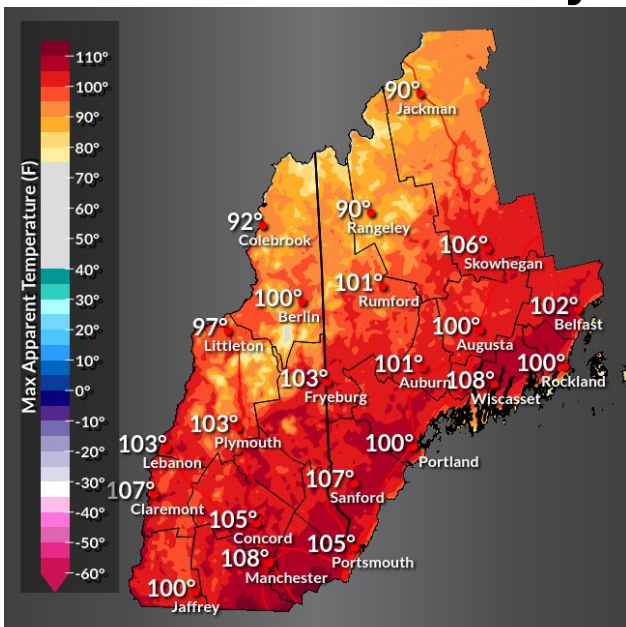
